The raw points are in WGS84. That probably explains the issue you noticed with the surveyor data not being assigned after importing the line work.			
They were the only import done after the beginning of the lock-down, and were imported still with the old admin.			
We need to sort this out, like:			
<ul style="list-style-type: none">- clean up the database- reproject the raw survey points file- import that reprojected file- re-import the line work layers			
Note this also coincides with the new admin baskets.
